

The Lancaster County Planning Commission is pleased to provide you with an opportunity to review and comment on places2040, the draft Lancaster County comprehensive plan. This document is available at <https://www.places2040.com> under "Draft Plan."

Comments on the plan are due to the planning commission by Oct. 24, 2018 and can be submitted by email to [info@places2040.com](mailto:info@places2040.com) or by U.S. mail to Lancaster County Planning Commission, 150 N. Queen St., Ste. 320, Lancaster, PA 17603.

The places2040 effort was led by the planning commission with the guidance and input of over 20 regional, countywide, and city organizations and agencies representing the public, private, and nonprofit sectors. Over three years, an extensive civic engagement process involved over 8,000 people, more than 100 presentations, and numerous opportunities for online engagement.

As required by the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, the planning commission will hold a public meeting to kick off an official 45-day review period on the plan. This meeting will take place on Mon., Aug. 27 at 2:30 pm in Conf. Room 102/104, 150 N. Queen St., Lancaster. The public entrance to the building is located on Chestnut St.

The review period will end with a public hearing. The Lancaster County Board of Commissioners will hold that hearing on Wed., Oct. 24, 2018 at 9:15 am in Conf. Room 701, 150 N. Queen St., Lancaster. Following the hearing, the Commissioners may choose to adopt the plan.
