ORDINANCE NO.	105

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STRASBURG TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE TO REVISE REGULATIONS GOVERNING REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR PLANS.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Strasburg, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Strasburg Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, Chapter 4, Plans and Plats; Required information, Section 402, Minor Subdivision Plans, Subsection E, Plan Notes and Conditions, shall be amended to add the following paragraphs:

- 14. Notification from DEP that approval of the sewage facilities plan revision or supplement has been granted or notice from DEP that such approval is not required. A note to that effect shall also be placed on the plan.
- 15. Written notice from the Township Engineer that all proposed improvements have been designed to the standards of the Township and that financial guarantees in a form suitable to the Township and Township Solicitor have been received.
- 16. Notification from the appropriate state and federal agencies that approvals have been received, permits have been issued, or are not required, for any proposed activities within streams, wetlands, or any other state or federally regulated body of water or earth moving activities regulated by state agencies. These permits or approvals include, but are not limited to erosion and sediment control, floodplain encroachment permits, dam safety permits, NPDES permits, stream encroachment permits, and general permits.

Section 2. All other sections, parts and provisions of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of the Township of Strasburg shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.

Section 3. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such

invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Board of Supervisors that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its enactment by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Strasburg as provided by law.



LCPC Meeting of June 12, 2017

The Lancaster County Planning Commission (LCPC) has reviewed the above-The amendment, when adopted, will revised referenced SALDO amendment. regulations governing required information for Minor Subdivision Plans.

PROPOSAL

Strasburg Township is proposing to amend the Minor Subdivision Plan requirements within the Strasburg Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. The following are among the proposed changes:

- Include notification from DEP that approval of the sewage facilities plan has been granted,
- Requirement notification that all appropriate state and federal permits has been received, and
- Require notification from the Township Engineer that all proposed improvements have been completed and a financial guarantee has been received by the Township.



COMMENTARY

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The Strasburg Township Supervisors adopted their first Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance in March 2016. In implementing the document, staff realized that several requirements were inadvertently omitted in the submission of a Minor Subdivision Plan that is required for other plan submissions. This text amendment remedies that omission.

The proposed requirements for submission of a Minor Subdivision plan is consistent with Article V, Section 503 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code regarding contents of a Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.

CONSISTENCY WITH COMPREHENSIVE PLANS

Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan

While the proposed amendments are not typically addressed in Balance, the Growth Management Element of the Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan. The amendments are generally consistent with the goal for regulations to be standard and consistent between municipal, state, and federal organizations.

Municipal Comprehensive Plan

The proposed amendment is not addressed in the Strasburg Region Comprehensive Plan adopted in 2006 by Strasburg Township and Strasburg Borough.
