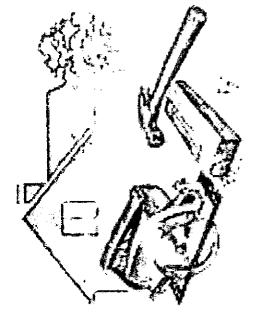

Applicants must have adjusted household incomes below the very low-income limits listed on the web site and be able to show repayment ability for the loan requested. Maximum outstanding balance must not exceed \$20,000.

Credit history must indicate a reasonable ability and willingness to meet financial obligations. There is no charge for a credit report.

✓ Liquid assets exceeding \$15,000 (\$20,000 for senior applicants) need to be considered and may affect loan or grant amount, for which applicants are eligible. Applicants must show a dependable source of income which is sufficient to repay the loan.

Written verification of the following: Social Security disability compensation, or retirement, SSI, Pension, Unemployment income will require a two year documentation and ANY OTHER non-work income (SSP) in the household for the current year. If you receive child support or alimony, the last two bank statements showing the electronic deposit as well as the court order.
- 4. Bid estimates (example FmHA intructions 1944-J, Exhibit B). Please provide the office with three (3) estimates for the work you want completed. (If you cannot obtain 3)- please submit (what you have)
- 5. Direction Map, copy of the Real Estate Taxes and copy of the deed to your property.
- 6. Form 3550-1, Authorization to Release information, signed by each member over the age of 18.
- 7. Copy of your most recent bank statements for all accounts.



- 8. Copy of your last Federal Income Tax Return with the W-2. If you do not file Federal Income Tax due to your low income, please send a written statement of explanation that is signed and dated.
- 9. Copy of your current Driver's License or if you do not drive, a copy of your social security or medicare card.
- 10. Please complete the enclosed form EMPLOYMENT AND ASSET CERTIFICATION.
- 11. If you are employed, please submit copies of the last 4 weeks of pay stubs as well as the current week for all employment. If you are employed and have any break in employment of 30 days, you must submit a written letter of explanation. This would also apply for seasonal employment.

Section 504 Rural Housing Loans and Grants for Families with Very Low Income

Available to eligible applications in rural areas, small towns and open country, or rural towns of \$10,000 population (Standard Metropolitan Statistical Counties) and up to 20,000 populations (Non-Standard Metropolitan Statistical Counties) that are not associated with an urban metropolitan area.

Loan and Grant Purposes:

Section 504 grant funds may be used only to pay costs for repairs and improvements which will remove identified health or safety hazards. Loan funds may be used to improve or modernize dwellings regardless of the removal of health and safety hazards.

All work shall be in accordance with local codes and standards:

Authorized loan and grant purposes include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Insulate
- 2. Provide storm windows
- 3. Purchase or repair heating systems
- 4. Repair roofs
- 5. Repair siding
- 6. Repair or supply structural supports
- 7. Provide a convenient and sanitary water supply
- 8. Provide bathroom facilities
- 9. Pay expenses, such as fees for legal and other technical services and reasonable connection fees for water, sewage and electricity or gas.

Who May Borrow:

Must be the owner and occupant of a dwelling located in an eligible rural area; quality as a very low income applicant; meet the credit worthiness requirements for the loan (if applicable); and be unable to obtain financial assistance from non-RD credit or grant.

Evidence of Ownership:

Each applicant will be required to submit evidence of ownership on the property. This may be a copy of the deed or other satisfactory evidence (ownership interest limited to the property to be repairs and be a minimum adequate site/limited acreage).

Section 504 Grant (without a Loan):

A grant may be made to an applicant meeting the requirements, provided the applicant is 62 years of age or older and has an income so low that he or she cannot repay any part of the loan. The repairs and improvements are not for cosmetic purposes, but are necessary to make the dwelling safe and sanitary and /or remove health hazards to occupants, their families, or the community. Section 504 Grant may not exceed a cumulative total of \$7,500.00.
